Each student possess a unique combination of multiple intelligence. Focused on the foundational learning of students and to give an emphasis on experiential learning curriculum based on NEP 2020 which highlights 6Cs which is driven by 5 Vs is implemented.

A comprehensive and balanced curriculum is therefore planned, focusing on the development of talents and skills which would help the students in becoming productive citizens, future leaders and lifelong learners. Our children are encouraged to be creative and therefore every opportunity is taken to develop their confidence, self-esteem, life skills & knowledge through technology, physical education and creative & performing arts.

Our integrated teaching methodology nurtures a stimulating learning environment to encourage students to learn at higher levels. Instructional strategies are student centered and include inquiry, active learning, experience-based learning, co-operative and participative learning activities. We focus on integration of knowledge, development of critical thinking, problem solving, performance skills and value based education.

Classroom teaching involves discussion, lively interaction with the students, PPT's, worksheets and smart class programs with notes, flowcharts and drawings. Simulated models and role plays give students an insight into real life situation. Projects are prepared by students for a deeper insight into various topics.

By adopting a student centered approach, we motivate students to develop higher order thinking skills. In classroom technologies – computers, audio visual tools, web based tools enhance technological skills in a child. An IT enabled resource centre provides support to keep pace with the dynamic nature of learning and pedagogy in education.



The Curriculum & Assessment: Key Stage Standard I & II

In the process of transforming these little minds, we strive to bring in a high academic standard and analytical thinking in them through Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation in each semester. It encompasses the oral skills, the written skills and the skills exhibited through various activities. This not only gives the pupil a friendly pace of learning but also enables the facilitator (the teacher) to have a constant observation of the child. The students will be evaluated on the basis of their performance based on the work done in the class & monthly worksheets. Results of the evaluation will be given at the end of each semester.

Lower Primary : Standard III to V

A holistic assessment system with an aim to improve writing skill and subjective knowledge of the students is adopted by dividing the syllabus uniformly according to the number of working days, which helps the students to grasp easily and learn each and every subject. The syllabus being wider in these classes, the students have to be prepared for slightly lengthy style of examination which is conducted three times in an year.



Upper Primary : Standard VI to VIII

At this stage, we follow a comprehensive and balanced curriculum. Our focus is to develop the talents and skills in the children. Introduction of subjects for learning and discussion of the more abstract concepts is done as per the GCERT syllabus where the students will be ready for at this stage across the subjects like science, mathematics, art & social science. To assess and evaluate the student's progress, projects, class activities, experiments along with semester wise examination as prescribed by the government is followed.



Secondary & Higher Secondary Stage: Standard IX to XII (Sci. & Com.)

The Secondary & Hr.Secondary School Programme consolidates knowledge of previous years and strengthens students' understanding of individual disciplines to help them choose their career path. The NCERT curriculum prescribed by GSHSEB - focus on in-depth experiential learning through projects, experiments, assignments, discussions and presentations.



The curriculum is well-mapped to nurture higher-order thinking skills (HOTS) and problem-solving skills of students. The school ensures equal opportunities which are extended to students for participating in various scholastic and co-scholastic activities.



For IX & XI - First Term and Second Term written exams will be of 50 marks. Third Term will be of 80 marks written exam and 20 marks internal assessment.

For X & XII - First Term and Preliminary written exams will be of 100 marks. Final Exams will be taken by the Board.

XII-Science - Practical Exams for Physics, Chemistry and Biology will be taken by the Board.

Computer practical exams for both Science & Commerce stream will be conducted by the school and accordingly marks will be sent to the Board.

For classes IX to XII, the promotion rules and the above stated evaluation system is subject to change as per the changes prescribed by the GSHSEB.

Each classroom is equipped with a wall mounted integrated Projector, Touch-screen Smart Board System, Multimedia Audio Visual Equipment with sound, so each classroom is itself a well furnished “TECHNO ROOM”. This concept empowers teachers to transform traditional black board and chalk classrooms into interactive sessions.

School labs are a great place for students which **help them enhance their learning by understanding the theoretical concepts which are taught in classrooms**. We have a very well-equipped & designed Computer labs with laptops and Science laboratories stocked with latest apparatus, that not only makes science experiments fun but also help students in achieving good academic results.

Beyond the Curriculum :

The theoretical knowledge is enhanced when a co-curricular activity related to the content taught is organized. Intellectual development of student's personality is achieved to a great extent in the classroom itself, but holistic development like character building, spiritual & moral values, physical growth, creativity and many more are backed up by co-curricular activities. 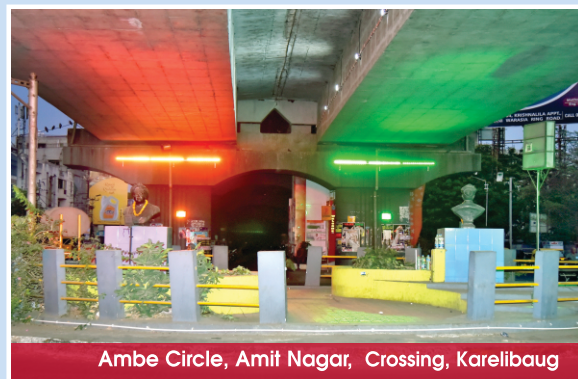
