

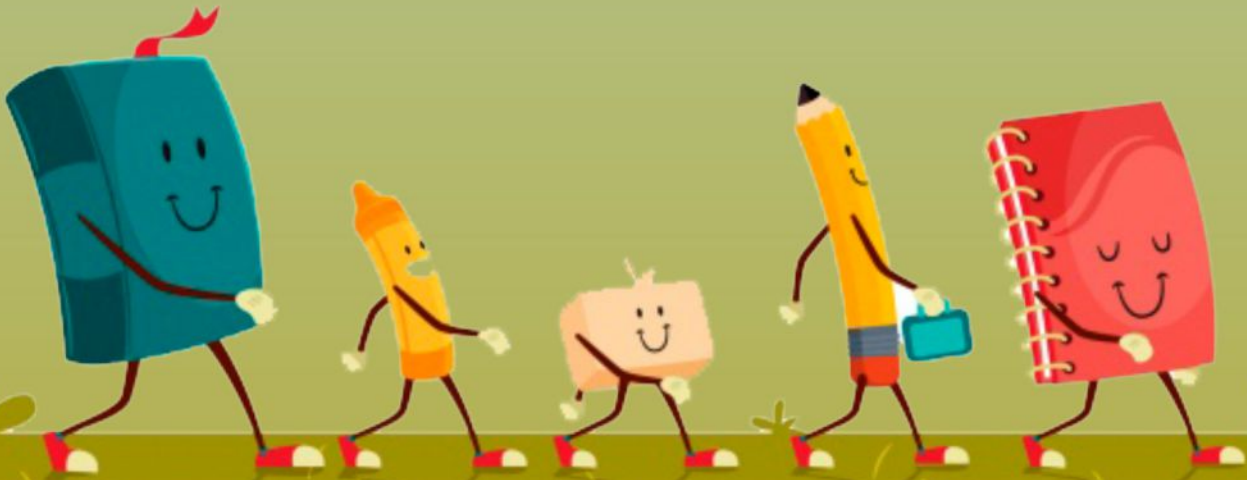

The formal teaching becomes very monotonous and makes the students repel school. The curriculum is planned, keeping in mind various stages of development of children through the play-way method of teaching. It encourages active participation in different games and activities.

During these early years of development, we plan our curriculum so as to create learners out of young children. We prepare effective instructional materials, provide equipments that help to develop their motor and mental skills, using the surroundings within and outside the classrooms. This makes their lessons interesting, meaningful, enjoyable and finally helps them to develop a love for learning.

"Learning by doing" is our teaching methodology. It has been devised to suit this age group. Over the years, we have perfected the art of first attracting the child's attention and then keeping his/her mind engaged through an array of fascinating activities that make the learning process interesting and absorbing.

Cognitive Skills

Cognitive skills are the core skills which are used by the brain to think, read, learn, remember, reason and pay attention. These skills are developed with various activities and games to understand concepts. For example to sing along, listen to different sounds, ask to make a choice, colours, shapes etc

Pre Math skills

These are skills taught to preschool and kindergarten students to prepare them for primary math subject. They are counting, sequencing, seriation, differentiation, matching, spatial, measuring, estimation etc... Lots of different activities are done at our school to teach these concepts.

Linguistic skills

These sets of skill enable the child to learn the sounds, pronunciations, vocabulary, and grammar for developing their speaking and listening skills. These are done by teaching phonics, recognition of letters and words, singing rhymes, listening to stories, and interpretation, drilling sessions, orals picture reading etc.

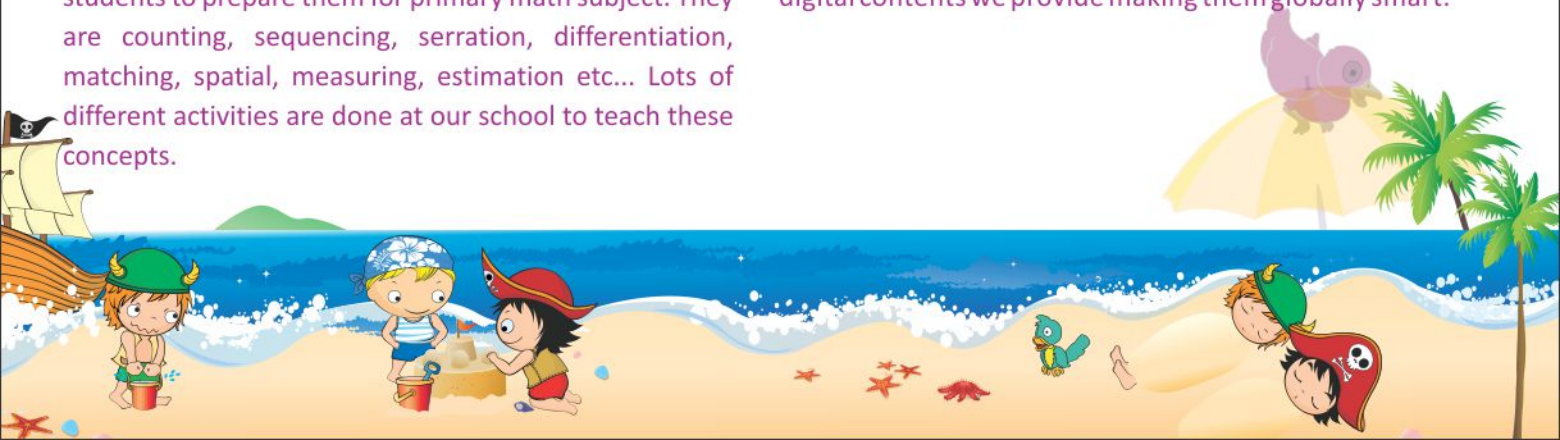


Socio-Emotional Skills

This includes child's experiences, expression, management of emotion and ability to make and preserve relationships with the people around them and the world at large. They learn majority of these at home, but the school provides a platform to interact with lot of kids of their age through which they learn the fundamentals. They are taught by conversation, interaction, group activities, class projects and team games.

Tech skills

Our children also learn the concepts with the use of latest digital contents we provide making them globally smart.





Motor skills

Motor Skills are physical skills that develop simultaneously according to age. These skills are developed automatically when a child is normal and healthy. We use the teaching pattern according to the skills developing naturally and enhance them by hundreds of small gross motor and fine motor skill activities. Finger tracing, clay molding, paper crumpling, finger printing, threading beads, lacing, cutting, etc. develop fine motor skill and activities like jumping, hopping, skipping, rolling, bending and stretching develop gross motor skill. We also use the combination of all these activities with academics to enhance the learning experience.

Environmental skills

Environmental skills are taught with a purpose to create individuals with empathy for our fellow human beings, other species on the earth and nature. These are taught with projects, role plays, moral stories, field visits etc. Understanding of the way our country works is made clear by assigning projects related to the topics like traffic rules, postal services, police, Law and Order Department, working of the government etc. Another part is the culture of our country we stay in. They learn all these by the celebrations of festivals, values and moral teachings through Ambe days-our very own innovation.





Special Days Celebrated with a tinge of affection

Different festivals like Ganesh Chaturthi, Rakshabandhan, Janmashtami, Navratri, Diwali, Christmas, etc. are celebrated to inculcate respect for all religions among the children.

Special days like Ambe Days are celebrated to give our children a vital facet meant to inculcate in the children, the values of Indian culture and sanskaras and portals of self-learning.

Colour day expresses and helps the student's imagination to develop social relationship and awareness about the environment.

Special days & celebrations are organized with the help of displays, demonstrations, presentations & stage-shows by young learners.

All this encourages them to develop a feeling of unity and brotherhood. A variety of project-based activities on different topics are discussed in the class throughout the year which includes stories, songs and group discussions.



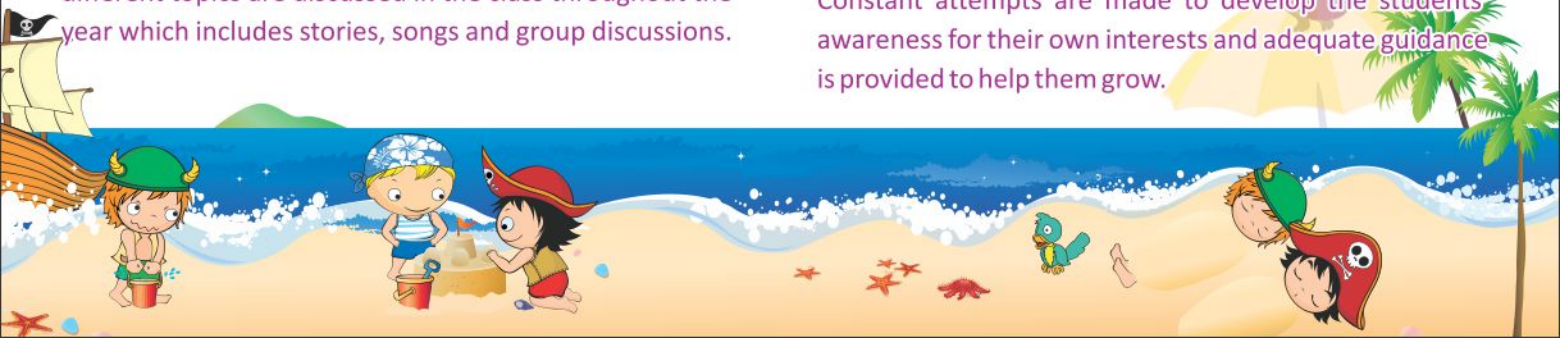
Projects are specially designed to motivate children through attractive colours and special themes. It comprises of a wide array of engaging activities that encourage children to become active learners.
